told her doctor that her visits to him couldn't interfere with her favorite Bible program on KLRF. In time Bernice recon-


nected to her former Christian faith.

that in just two steps:


- 1) Type in klrf.org on your browser.

## Your Inside Scoop—Antenna Replacement is a \$22,000 Project The Corner Where Savvy Donors Stay in the KLRF Loop
