Melted "Cheezy" Sauce

Need something cholesterol-free for festive occasions? Try this tasty alternative for cheese sauce over crispy corn chips, as nacho sauce, or as a sauce for vegetables or baked potatoes.

Makes 2/1/2 cups (ten 1/4-cup servings)

2 cups hot water

1/4 cup raw cashews, rinsed

1 4 oz. jar pimientos

3 tablespoons nutritional yeast

2 tablespoons cornstarch or arrowroot powder

1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice

1 1/2 teaspoons salt

1/2 teaspoon onion flakes or powder

1/4 teaspoon garlic powder

1/2 teaspoon cumin (optional)

chili powder to taste (optional)

1 can diced green chilies (optional)



Process cashews and hot water in a blender until velvety smooth. Add remaining ingredients and continue beating until very smooth.
