In this series, the late Pastor Liversidge shares important timeless Christcentered messages meant for our days.

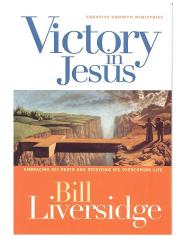
When we learned that

Science Shows Pleasant Thoughts May Slow Brain Aging

Last Thanksgiving is history, however gratefulness is still in season. Research shows thinking pleasant thoughts stimulates the parasympathetic (calming) part of our nervous system and benefits our general health.

Grateful people experience improved sleep, increased alertness, more energy and fewer physician visits. Gratitude results in less depression and boosts the immune system. Inflammation, which plays a role in many diseases including heart disease, decreases and the effect of aging on the brain is slowed. Grateful people tend to exercise more and spontaneously eat healthier diets.

Not naturally grateful? Gratitude can be learned. Just focus on one small thing each day. Don't compare yourself to others "better off" than you. Consider a daily gratitude journal, or tell someone else your gratitude. When tempted to complain, state your thankfulness instead, and you just may notice an upturn in your social life as well!

Featured Recipe

Nazareth Village Lentil Soup

2 cups lentils

4 cups water

1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil (optional)

3 spring (green) onions, chopped

2 cloves garlic, minced

1 teaspoon baking powder (optional)

1 teaspoon cumin

1 teaspoon salt (more if desired)

Black pepper (to taste, optional)

Mix together and simmer on low to moderate heat 1 to 2 hours. Serves 4.
